Regular Meeting of the Board

June 22, 2010

École À la Découverte

Given that the school council from École À la Découverte requested the relocation of the school in 2011-2012 and given that the lease with Edmonton Catholic Schools ends in July 2011, trustees mandated administration to look into the relocation of the school before the 2011-2012 school year.

Appointment of school principal

The Board ratified the appointment of Jean Doyon as principal of École La Prairie for a one-year probationary term from August 1, 2010 to July 30, 2011.

Memorandum of agreement between Conseil des écoles francsaskoises (CÉF) and Conseil scolaire Centre-Nord (CSCN)

Board administration will explore the feasibility of signing a memorandum of agreement with CEF. Saskatchewan's francophone school board is opening a preschool to grade 5 francophone school in Lloydminster in 2010-2011.

Partnership with Edmonton Public Library (EPL)

The Board was invited by Linda Cook, Chief Executive Officer for EPL, to sign a partnership agreement between EPL and CSCN.

École Boréal

Minister Hancock confirmed a \$706,000 emergent grant for replacing an exterior wall at École Boréal in Fort McMurray, but denied \$194,000 for work deemed "non essential". The renovation period is not finalized, although it could take four to six months to complete the work.

Superintendent's report

Congratulations to École À la Découverte – the school was selected to pilot a *Setting the Direction* program in 2010-2011.

Alberta Education invited Centre-Nord to pilot the Maplewood software that will enable data sharing between school authorities and the Province within the framework of the *Provincial Approach to Student Information* (PASI) initiative.

Congratulations to Suzanne Foisy-Moquin, president of Roots of the Change Foundation, a charitable organization whose goal is to support financially and morally the work of Father Denis Hébert in Nicaragua.
