

Design approval for École Desrochers

The Board adopted the design for École Desrochers, a new facility that will be fully shared with Jasper Jr/Sr High School as of the 2014-2015 school year. Our partner, Grande Yellowhead Regional SD, adopted a similar resolution on January 18.

The superintendents of both school authorities continue their work in developing two agreements for the operations and programming / sharing of the new school.

New school in Red Deer (École La Prairie)

On January 23, Trustee Nicole Lorrain will make a presentation to the City of Red Deer asking it to amend the existing conditions of the development plan for the construction of the new school on the Aspen Ridge site. This site is designated for a K-9 school while the Board is calling for the designation to accommodate a K-12 school.

On December 14, the Board approved a transfer of \$600,000 from its accumulated surplus to its capital reserves to finance the expansion of the gymnasium and the addition of a mezzanine for the new school, an additional 189 m².

Minister of Education Thomas Lukaszuk's visit to École La Prairie

Nicole Lorrain, trustee, and Jean Doyon, principal, were very pleased with Minister Lukaszuk's visit on December 7. A ministry official wrote, "Jean, his staff and students represented Alberta's francophone schools very well. The minister noted that our students are bilingual and proud of their heritage. ...
