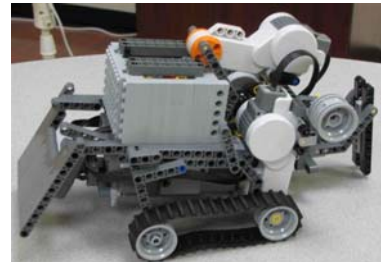
### MINISTER OF EDUCATION AT ALBERTA TEAM ROBOTICS DEMONSTRATION
