CENSUS FOR BOARD ELECTIONS AT CONSEIL SCOLAIRE CENTRE-NORD

EDMONTON, March 30, 2010 - In anticipation of the upcoming election of school board trustees, the Conseil scolaire Centre-Nord is required to update its list of electors by carrying out a census.

Results of this census will determine the proportion of Catholic school members and Public school members to be elected to the Board.

An individual can participate in a census and be eligible to vote in an election for the members of a Regional authority, if that individual:

- is 18 years of age older,
- is a Canadian citizen,
- has been a resident of Alberta for 6 consecutive months immediately preceding election day. In addition, an individual must be able to respond to at least one of the following criteria:
- is a parent of a child or children enrolled (kindergarten to grade 12) in a school or schools operated by Conseil scolaire Centre-Nord,
- was enrolled as a student in a school operated by a Regional authority and received an Alberta High School Diploma or Certificate from a Regional authority,
- is the biological or adoptive parent of an individual who was enrolled as a student in a school operated by a Regional authority and received an Alberta High School Diploma or Certificate from a Regional authority.

Census forms are available at the school board office, at all schools operated by Conseil scolaire Centre-Nord, and on its Internet site www.centrenord.ab.ca. The census form will also be published in the French weekly, Le Franco, and in selected English weeklies. Only those forms received on or before **April 30, 2010**, at 4 p.m., will be accounted for in the results of this census.
