



Minister of Education Thomas Lukaszuk to visit École La Prairie!



Red Deer, December 2, 2011 - As part of his provincial tour, Minister of Education Thomas Lukaszuk will visit École La Prairie (4810-35 St., Red Deer) on Wednesday, December 7. École La Prairie is the only francophone school the Minister will visit during his tour.

Minister Lukaszuk will be at the school from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. The students will lead him on a school visit and then to the gym for a concert presentation, including music from the school band that won a first prize at the Lacombe Music Festival.

École La Prairie is the only francophone school serving the greater Red Deer area. This year, 124 students from kindergarten to grade 12 attend the school, and 19 children are enrolled in the preschool program *Pays de jeux*.

In May, the provincial government announced the construction of a new school for La Prairie, that will allow all students to benefit from modern premises suited for elementary and secondary levels.

The media are invited to the school for this important visit of the Minister Lukaszuk.
